**“The Best Ever?”**

2 Kings 18...1–5

Reference texts:

2 Kings 18–20; 2 Chronicles 29–32; Isaiah 36–39

King Hezekiah was like no other, we could say “the best ever,” when recounting the lives of the kings of Judah. And from observing the way he ‘did life’ we can gain some insightful principles for our lives. From King Hezekiah we can learn that...

**I. Our decisions are just that—“OUR” decisions.**

- a. His dad’s influence, was anything but good.
- b. He decided to do what the Lord desired, rather than take a path of “least resistance.”

**II. Our responses to past difficulties, MAY PREDICT our responses to future difficulties.**

- a. As seen from his ‘terminal illness.’
- b. As seen when an ‘enemy attacks.’

**III. Sometimes “BEING GRACED” can cause us to become “UNGRACIOUS”**

- a. Exposed when he hosted a grand tour.
- b. Provoking a rebuke from the Lord.
- c. Revealed in his response?
